PUPIL LEADERS:

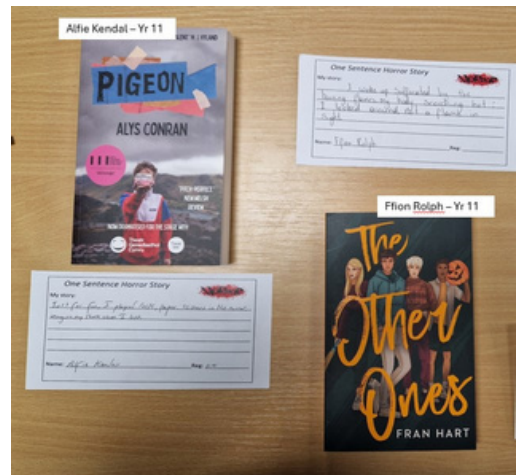
Collectively, the pupil leaders wanted to say this:

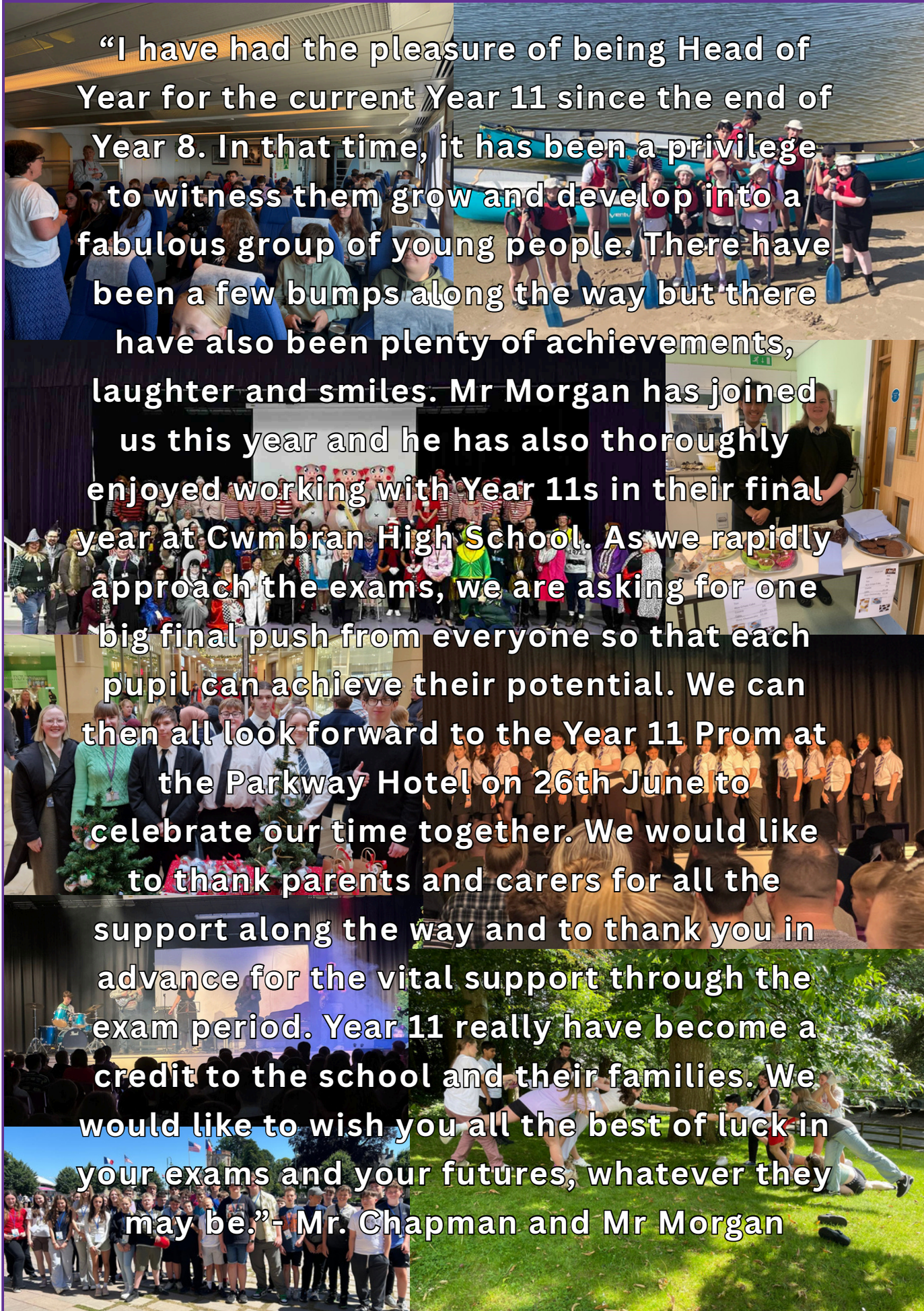
